Trumpets

Trumpets

- Called Rosh Hashana today.
- It's the first of the three fall Feast.
- We learned from the Feast of Pentecost that we have been harvesting the fields for the past 2000 years.
- Trumpets begins the fall festival when the crops have been gathered in.

The Feasts of Trumpets

- Could the trumpet sound made at this feast be the call to the Church?
- The events signified by this final festival season are the great hope of humanity.
- This harvest season actually includes four different festivals, all of them with distinct meaning.

The Feasts of Trumpets

- They are the Feast of Trumpets, the Day of Atonement, the Feast of Tabernacles and the Last Great Day.
- Indeed, as the events depicted by these days unfold, the world will be gripped by devastating warfare (Matthew 24:6, 21-22; Revelation 6:4; 9:1-21).
- Is this the war of Gog and Israel?

The Feasts of Trumpets

- Could this be the trumpet of 1ST Thessalonians 4:16-18?
- Or the trumpet of 1St Corinthians 15:51-52?
- Or the trumpet of Revelation 4:1-2?
- Hear me on this, I am not saying that the Rapture will take place in the fall, I think the Rapture is *Imminent!*

The Feasts of Trumpets

- 1ST Thessalonians 4:16-18 tells us of the upcoming rapture, and because there is a feast of Trumpets some would make the connection to the Rapture.
- 1St Corinthians 15:51-52 also speaks of the sound of a trumpet, and in Revelation 4:1-2 trumpets are again spoken of.
- The question before the house is, is the Feasts of Trumpets the time of the Rapture?
